## Step 1: My Educational Benefits

### Legacy Montgomery GI Bill

- A full-time student can expect to receive up to \$1,994 monthly for full-time institutional training.
- This benefit program expires ten years after service.
- Students have a maximum of \$71,784 in total benefits, depending upon the type of program chosen.

#### Post 9/11 GI Bill

- Pays all of the tuition for any in-state public school, but caps at \$22,805 per year for private schools.
- Students must have served on active duty for a minimum of a 36 months to gain the 100% rate, otherwise. this benefit is a prorated lesser dollar amount.
